Date: Sunday 11th October 2020

Objective: Royston Spillway

Royston Spillway was rebuilt and completed in the summer of 2017, and it was time for a clearance of growth by NWDCT volunteers last Sunday.

As well as the back of the spillway and soke being cleared of the growth of brambles, etc., the canal owner of this section used his digger to clear the (wet) soke south of the spillway. The (wet) material was taken away using the tracked dumper, which was driven by volunteer Terry. Meanwhile, the (dry) material from the spillway soke was collected on top of the spillway and then burnt (mostly).

Two volunteers also cut the willows growing in the canal near Royston Bridge.
