Objective: Continue to clear brash/saplings along the canal and banks

At 8.30am we erected the Heras fencing on the foot path at Ebridge with a notice saying the foot path will be closed today for maintenance.

The Pontoon was taken down to site with the reed cutter used to push it there, this was turned at 90 degrees to get access to both sides of the bank. At the workshop all necessary tools were loaded on to the Multicar and taken down to the site along with the Doosan and Dumper.

The remaining brush and small saplings were removed and burnt up on site. Stopped for lunch.

While we were sitting there the trip boat and the butty attached to the front with a large crowd of visitors so we had to quickly turn the pontoon round to let them through.

The tractor and trailer were used all afternoon to remove all the large arising's from the last work party and today's work and taken back to the workshop. Small bits of reed and debris was raked out of the water and tidied up.



All the machinery was taken back and the Heras fencing taken down to open up the foot path. We finished work at 4pm.
