Arrived at Purdy's Marsh and worked our way down to the marked section for this year's cut.

With the digger centred up in the middle of each row CH was able to make a 180 degree cut and in doing so was able to push the arising's to one side, this was then raked up into windrows. Gradually we kept moving along the marsh in this fashion cutting about quarter of an acre.

When dried out these rows can be burnt, but at the moment it was too tinder dry to burn.

MW found a patch of Balsam which she has now removed.
