Working there for the rest of the day, Alan B cut a pathway through the marsh including cutting round the two scrape ponds.



Meanwhile the rest of the volunteers set to with the long reach saw and cut back all the overhanging branches. These were cut up and piled alongside the newly cut path. We achieved to about halfway.



We cleared up tools and returned to base for 3:30pm
