Objective:- Moor platform at Honing Lock



The required equipment and materials were loaded out from the yard and taken to the Canoe Field.

Two people took the pontoon and the platform up to Honing Lock on the canal. The rest of the volunteers went to Honing Lock by car (Fact:- the journey by road entails turning right seven times in a row). The area for the platform to be moored was tidied up.



The large concrete beam across the path by the lock was moved, as requested by the proprietor, to reduce damage to canoes in portage.

The pontoon returned to the Canoe Field. The remainder of the volunteers re-assembled the platform and moored it in position. The tools were carried to the cars parked at the far side of the lock - the path is very muddy.

A local resident was very complimentary about the platform

Returning to the Canoe Field, lunch was taken in the sunshine and then the equipment was returned to the yard.
