Objective:- Remove brash from banks left from trimming alders

Work party report



This was a half day work party to clear brash from the canal banks on the Ebridge Pound at the request of the OCC prior to their desilting next week.

Despite the weather forecast the larger of the two LCN pontoons was loaded with hand tools and taken down the pound from Spa Common.



A fire was started on the east bank to burn the brash. The pontoon was used to load out the brash from the west bank and deliver it to the east bank to be burnt.

The work was completed within two hours and the pontoon and equipment returned to the depot. Job done and a good test of the volunteers' wet weather gear. This was another task enabled by the new LCN equipment. Nice to note the silent running did not seem to disturb the swans.
